Men's Shed

I received an email this week which announced that the Federal Government was committing an additional \$4.5 Million over the next 3 years to support the Men's Shed program. Well that made me curious to learn more about the program.

The Men's Shed is a community-based, non-profit, non-commercial organisation that is accessible to all men and whose primary activity is to provide a safe and friendly environment (the Shed) where men are able to work on meaningful projects at their own pace in their own time in the company of other men. A major objective is to advance the wellbeing and health of the Men.

The closest Men's Shed to our district is in Aldgate. There is also one in Mt Barker and a couple down at Morphett Vale.

So this brings me to wonder whether there is any interest from the residents of Cherry Gardens and the surrounding district to establish a Men's Shed here. If we had one here then as well as servicing the Men from our district it could also service areas such as Coromandel Valley, Clarendon, Blackwood, and even Aberfoyle Park, Flagstaff etc.

There are more than 800 Men's Shed operating throughout Australia and it would appear that it is well organised with a good support organisation behind it and some funding is available from the government to help get them up and running.

If there is any interest from the community then the Cherry Gardens Community Association and Cherry Chatter would be prepared to take a leadership role in getting a Men's Shed in our district. One thought would be to build one at the Recreation Ground (somewhere near the clubrooms or change rooms) but people might have other suggestions and we would be interested to get your feedback.

It would also be good to hear from any men from the district that would like to get involved and help in getting this program established here. Hope to hear from you soon either by email or phone.

FROM THE ONKAPARINGA COUNCIL

Monterey pine trees on Main Road, Cherry Gardens

For the past 12 months the City of Onkaparinga has been monitoring the health of the Monterey pines on Main Road at Cherry Gardens.

The trees, located on council road reserve opposite the Memorial Hall, were assessed through an independent tree report commissioned by council in June 2013. The report shows most of the trees are in a below average and slowly deteriorating state of health. This is associated with the local environmental conditions and the very close spacing of the trees, which has resulted in intense inter-tree competition for resources, especially light and soil moisture.

A recent car accident outside of the hall has accelerated the deterioration of some of the pine trees, prompting the need for a staged removal of the trees. Five of the trees deemed to be high risk will be removed before the end of the year, with follow up removals to occur over the next 12 months as the trees continue to decline.

Council will select another species of tree to replace those removed and create an effective wind break for the hall. In selecting the species, consideration will be given to the height of the fully grown tree to minimise the amount of pruning required below the power lines.

The 24 remaining trees appear to be the remnants of between 50 and 70 trees planted sometime between 1963 and 1978. The trees are not protected by the Native Vegetation Act 1991 or Development Act 1993.

City of Onkaparinga CEO Mark Dowd says council recognises the multiple benefits trees provide, but community safety must be the first priority.

"We are committed to maintaining the highest possible standards of tree care and we seek to retain trees wherever possible, however there are times when trees must be removed because they pose genuine risk issues or are rapidly declining in health."

"We are also aware that members of the local community were seeking the trees be added to the local heritage listing as a memorial for fallen soldiers. In response to this we will honour the symbolism of the trees as part of our current upgrades to the

Cherry Gardens Soldiers Memorial."

Upgrades to the Soldiers Memorial including the arboretum commenced in May. The upgrades involve site clean-up, veteran tree management, biodiversity work, seed collection, tree identification, fence replacement, path development and interpretive signage. The works will be undertaken in three stages and are expected to be completed by Anzac Day 2016.



OVER THE STABLE DOOR

Greetings Fellow Equines and Horse Owners!

Last month we looked at getting our horse to 'park' whilst mounting; the ultimate aim being that he will do this not only in his comfort zone (ie. the arena), but anywhere at all. This can be such a useful tool and can be used on trail rides, opening gates and mounting up in any other new or strange places. The better this training is done, the more you will find that your horse relaxes in these situations. In the beginning, it is good to bear in mind the three 'R's' – recency, repetition and reward. So basically what this means in the early days of training, do many repetitions and reasonably close together, say 3 or 4 days in a row, with 3 good repetitions on each day. Each time he gets it right, reward with a wither scratch and a verbal 'good boy'. Be careful to only reward when he gets it right. For example you may need 4 or more repetitions before he has that lightbulb moment. Save the wither scratch for then, as this will be most reinforcing for a repetition of the same behaviour. As he improves, he will get 3 right in a row. When he is doing this reliably is a good time to change the scenario. With a horse that is really 'spooky', you may want to only change the mounting up place by a few metres. This will depend on your horse – some will pick it up quite easily and not bat an eyelid at moving to a different place. Do keep in mind though when doing early training like this to only change one thing at a time. So just because he is 'parking' at home may be too



hard mentally for him to attempt this out at a competition with a million things to distract him. Most horses will have a spooky spot in the arena where they are more reluctant to go, so by ensuring that you can place him anywhere in this environment will most certainly help when he is outside this area. If it all falls apart, consider what factors are different, or what may have caused the upset. You can always go back to your original training area and look for 'holes' in his responses. Look again for his 3 consistent responses and then try moving him a shorter distance away and repeat. Of course, all this may not be necessary, but it is handy to know what to do when it falls in a heap! Next, once on board, does he move off, eager to 'get on' with it, full of joie de vivre? Remember that we don't want him to move off unless we have given him a signal. More on this next month....anecdotal I did hear of a rider in the UK whose horse was in the habit of moving off as she mounted. This happened one

day on a trail ride, but something spooked him before she got her other foot in the stirrup, he bolted and she was unfortunately killed. This was an accident that was totally avoidable with correct training. Finally, some other homework for the coming weeks – review your bushfire action plan, be on the lookout for those upcoming weeds and take appropriate action, review your paddocking/grazing system – can it be improved by rotation, resting, mixed grazing, extra fencing and so on. My owners are very pleased with me this winter as I have been holding my weight (ie. not gaining) and looking so trim. I actually feel good too and am finding it easier to go forward!
