Around 400 people attended the service this year at the Cherry Gardens Soldiers memorial and reflected on the sacrifice made by the local men of the district those many years ago. Pastor Roger Waldron from the local Cherry church spoke of mateship and Australians helping Australians through war and conflict in the armed services and through adversity such as floods, bushfires and other natural disasters in the volunteer services.

Along with a number of dignitaries that attended many commented on how good it was to see the local footy team players attend. Following the service most of the people walked down to the Memorial Hall for the traditional BBQ breakfast that the Community Association puts on for the district. It was a good feed and thanks goes to everyone on the committee and to the church for helping out on the day. A number of the Ironbank Cherry Gardens football players took part in the ceremony where we remembered the local men of the district that died in the two world wars. It was a fitting reminder that those that lost their life were a similar age to the footy players that did the readings. For anyone interested the community association has available a booklet that traces the lives, service and final resting place for each of these men that is available for \$25.

Next year, being the 100th anniversary of the Gallipoli landings, there will be special services countrywide and this will also be the case for Cherry Gardens. We will update on the plans next year.

### **OVER THE STABLE DOOR - with HAMISH**

Greetings Fellow Equines and Horse Owners!

Winter is just about on us, with some really welcome rain to soak up into those dry paddocks. Regular picking up of your horse's manure will keep your paddocks looking good and reduce occurrence of worm infestation. If you are able to yard or stable your steeds overnight that will also help keep the ground in good condition. If your horse is perhaps not looking his/ her best, it would pay to keep up your worming program from now through to spring/summer. Getting a worm count done by your vet will give you a really good idea of where your horse is at too.

In your horse training, being aware of his body language and hoof movements will tell you many things about where he is at. Body language may be things like the position of his ears, his

head, body and tail. Stiff forward pointing ears tells you that something in his environment is actually more important to him than whatever you are doing with him. A raised head is generally associated with adrenalin (and a flight response). A lowered head is associated with calmness and a lower heart rate (scientifically proven). If you are in the saddle, his sides or back may feel 'hard' and tense, again more interested in outside stimuli than you. When the adrenalin is up, so will the tail be; it may also be clamped down hard or swishing. So really we have no excuses to ignore this behaviour as the horse is really telling us something in the only way he can. Coupled with all this body language will be the movement of his feet. As the flight response kicks in, his feet will be moving randomly (without an aid from you), there will be no rhythm, the movements may be

staccato (quick and irregular). There will be a loss of straightness as well as lightness in your hands whether leading or in hand. It all sounds pretty dreadful, so what to do? In all our training, because the horse is a creature of flight (which he will revert to when things fall apart), we need to train him so that he doesn't get a chance to express that response. Taking control of the front feet is your main aim. A good start here is simply training him to halt or park (in a safe enclosed area ) in hand. This can be done with just a halter and rope. A long training or dressage whip can be used to tap him below the knee to move him back if he tries to follow you as you move away. At first you may be only able to move one or two steps away, but if you are consistent, he will soon get the idea. The key ingredients here are consistency and timing. As he

gets the idea, you can start to move away at different angles and eventually be able to move all around and behind him. Eventually you will be able to move quite a distance away and do other chores while he stands still. As this becomes more reliable, you can add in a word like 'back' before you tap. Because they are very 'place specific', i.e. will do it in one place, you need to try this exercise in a different (safe) place to be sure that it is super reliable. Be careful also that when you tap with the whip, that the first tap(s) must be light, followed by quicker taps rather than heavier taps. As with all our signals to the horse we are aiming to achieve responses from the lightest of taps. When he gets it right, it is

good to reward him with a scratch at the wither, as this will both lower his heart rate and relax him. When we do want him to move, make sure that it is from the signal you give from the rope, not from you walking forward, as we want him to respond to a pressure, which we can then release when he walks forwards. Again, the end result is that he will move forward from the lightest of pressure at the poll. Well, back to my lovely green pastures. Enjoy time with your equines. Hamish





### **CHURCH NEWS**

#### WHAT ARE THE ODDS?

Where the odds are known, mathematicians express them as probabilities. If you buy one raffle ticket and 5000 are sold, your chances of winning are one in 5000. Not very likely. In the Old Testament there are more than 60 prophecies about the Messiah that were fulfilled by only one man, Jesus. These prophecies include:

- He would be a descendant of King David
- He would be born of a virgin
- He would be born in the little town of Bethlehem
- He would be rejected by the religious leaders of the day
- He would ride triumphant into Jerusalem on a donkey
- He would be betrayed for 30 pieces of silver
- His hands and feet would be pierced, but his bones not broken
- He would die alongside criminals
- He would be buried with a rich man

Some of the predictions were made more than 800 years before Jesus was born. Skeptics say the New Testament writers added these details to fit the prophecies. Others claim Jesus went about deliberately doing things to make the prophecies come true. To be born in Bethlehem Jesus would need to have asked his parents before he was born, to go there from Nazareth where they lived. The prophecy about his hands and feet being pierced was written before crucifixion was invented. Stoning was the practice at the time. And the Romans usually broke a prisoners legs during crucifixion to hasten death. But a Roman soldier refused to do so at the cross of Jesus so no bone was broken.

The sum of the probabilities of all the prophecies being fulfilled by one man are so slim as to be impossible. But nothing is impossible for God. And the decisions about events like where Jesus' parents were when he was born and whether his legs were broken on the cross were made by the Romans, the rulers of that region at that time. Christians are absolutely sure that Jesus is the promised Messiah because all of these predictions coming together in one man could not be by chance.

#### **ONKAPARINGA COUNCIL NEWS**

#### **WASTE RECYCLING**

Residents can now recycle a wider range of household materials on the spot at home. Items including pots and pans, plastic kitchenware and plastic toys can now be recycled in existing recycling bins, thanks to a new recycling partnership between the City of Onkaparinga, SKM Recycling and Solo Resource Recovery. City of Onkaparinga Waste Education Of-

City of Onkaparinga Waste Education Officer Lynda Wedding said the deal was a huge win for the environment and residents.

'This new arrangement means we can greatly reduce the amount of waste going to landfill.'

'There is nothing residents need to do other than be aware of the new items they can recycle and simply put them in their recycle bin,' Lynda said.

An awareness campaign is continuing across the region, including community presentations, updated information sheets and our website to ensure as many people as possible are aware of the change.

'We ask everyone to help us by telling their neighbours and friends who live in our region about the new materials that can now be placed in recycling bins,' Lynda said

The Council's current service provider Solo Resource Recovery will continue collecting both the recycling and green bins, while the composting of organics will occur via a subcontract arrangement with Peats Soils. The Council will also continue to collect general domestic waste (red lid bins).

The Council's existing three bin system will continue as normal with general waste collected weekly, recyclables fortnightly and green organics every four weeks.

More environmental benefits will be achieved through reduced air pollution as Solo's collection trucks will comply with Euro 5 emissions standards and use 20 per cent biodiesel fuel.

The collection operations will also be certified carbon neutral, with Solo buying carbon offsets to achieve this.

#### NEW ITEMS YOU CAN PLACE IN YOUR RECYCLE BIN

- •Pots and pans
- •Plastic toys
- •Kitchenware (eg. plastic bowls, lunch boxes)
- •Plastic cups and reusable drink bottles
- •Rigid plastic items (eg. laundry baskets, large buckets, pot plant containers)
- •Plastic bottles with lids on (flatten bottle if possible)
- •This also includes spray bottles and pump bottles

### YOU CAN STILL RECYCLE THESE ITEMS AS WELL

- •Paper and cardboard (shredded paper can be recycled in the green organics bin)
- •Magazines, newspapers and junk mail
- •Glass bottles and jars (lids removed)
- ·Cartons milk, juice stock etc.
- •Cans aluminium, steel, aerosol (spray cans)
- Metal lids
- •Plastic bottles and containers (no foam)
- Just drain bottles and empty containers no need to waste water washing out




