COUNTRY FIRE SERVICE

After a year with lots of disruption and challenges, here we are in 2021! Let's hope this year settles down to be completely standard and routine. Please be mindful that we are well into in the fire danger season and please exercise caution with outdoor activities.

We have been kept busy prior to Christmas with a few local callouts but South Australia has had many fires due cropping and dry lightning. The Sturt Group was tasked to support with major fire outbreaks near Overland Corner in the Riverland and also at Yumali (slightly further south east of Coonalpyn) a week later. This saw appliances and crews from Cherry Gardens traveling to these areas to assist. When we support other regions, protection of our local area is always taken into consideration – resources are always on hand to cope with any local event.

The Sturt Group bulk water carrier/ foam suppression appliance is based at Cherry Gardens station and generally crewed by local members. It has very impressive firefighting capability and will be one of our main water sources for any fires south of Cherry Gardens Rd. As with Cherry Gardens 34 & 34P, it is a large unit and requires clearance to be able to access areas. The below picture (taken before the 20/21 summer) details these clearances and if we do not fit, we cannot go in. Please use this info as a guide for driveways, gates and rural fencing.

Please keep fire safety foremost in your thoughts this summer. If you notice any smoke or fire, please call 000 immediately to initiate an emergency response.

The Cherry Gardens Garden Club will not meet again until Monday February 8^{th} , the venue is yet to be decided.

The most informative presentation by Mark Smith of Adelaide Veggie Gardens' of his journey from wanting to grow his own vegetables, through to establishing wicking veggie gardens commercially was our last for 2020.

We saw examples of the various wicking beds Mark had designed and used along the way to reduce time and water usage costs. Like all of us Mark found that one of the drawbacks to the home gardener, when establishing wicking beds, is the sheer effort involved in filling them.



Traditionally one places a lot of rubble below a layer of geotextile to create a useful depth and level below the soil in which vegetables are actually growing in a wicking bed.

We saw many different shapes, sizes and types of materials used to make beds. Mark used gardening knowledge gained during and since childhood, his scientific background, combined with years of research, trial and error.

He finally discovered what he has since found to be the most convenient and productive way of making the perfect wicking bed for growing vegetables. He has found a product called "Waterups". The design of these recycled, black, plastic, hollow cubes with four "legs" which not only increase their height and stability but also double as "wicks" once the growing medium fills them up. Mark also taught us how to mix the ideal veggie growing soil mixture for wicking beds using, perlite coir and compost and recommended the use of rain water to avoid a build-up of minerals and salts which can result from using Adelaide water.

In keeping with the new Covid "normal" we enjoyed our cups of coffee - sans supper.

GEORGE'S GARDENING SUGGESTIONS FOR JANUARY 2021

- Well the expected higher rainfall forecast for spring did not eventuate and gardens (especially the trees) will be looking for a deep watering on a regular basis through summer. Water prices have eased a little so you won't feel so bad about turning on the tap.
- Dead-head and fertilise your roses to promote a good show of autumn flowers. Any summer flowering annuals should also be cut back after they finish flowering. Do these tasks when you expect a run of cooler days.
- Tough flowers such as vincas, marigold and petunia can still be planted as seedlings but will need watering often in very hot conditions. Remember to mulch!
- With care, tomatoes and corn can still be planted
- Compost matures quite readily in the warmer months so all of those prunings (finely chopped) and lawn clippings together with some chook poo will make a good brew. If you still have some old compost to hand, your pumpkins, cucumbers and zucchinis will thrive on it at this time of year.
- If you have a particularly hot area in your garden at this time of year, now would be a good time to think about a shade tree to plant next spring. There are plenty on offer and the first decision is whether it will be evergreen or deciduous. If you are not so keen on a tree or two, a climber over some sort of structure would also be great to give a cooling effect in your garden.

OVER THE STABLE DOOR with Hamish



Greetings Fellow Equines and Horse Owners!

Weather is always a good subject for discussion, as those who are animal owners will know. Whether (pardon the pun!) it is hot, cold, wet or windy, there is always

something to be done to keep our animals more comfortable.

Horses do come with their own inbuilt fur coat which keeps us protected in most situations. Say in hot weather, we need shade and ad lib access to clean fresh water. In extreme heat we can drink up to 60 litres per day. This will need to be checked regularly and replaced with fresh water if it has gone slimy. This can happen if the water is in an old bath and the water is dam water. We do also appreciate a lovely hose down on a hot day too, but don't scrape the water off, as our body will cool as the water evaporates. With the hosing, be careful not to overdo it, as it can deplete the hair from the natural oils. Also make sure that the lower legs, particularly in the back of the pastern area are dried off with a towel. If they are left damp and with too much hosing, greasy heel can develop.

Some of us have white facial markings and are susceptible to a bit of sun burn. There is specially formulated sun screen for horses which is helpful. Please don't use the human product as the PH content can be different and have adverse effects on our skin. If in doubt, then a sun veil can be used too. Just be careful that it fits well and can't catch on anything.

In the cold weather, then we tend to get rugged. Again be careful with the amount of rugging. The modern synthetic rugs are very warm and we will sweat on even a mildly sunny day. Do you know that over 5 degrees and we don't really need a rug? However, when a chill factor is involved, that is wind and rain together then that is a different thing. Rugging will definitely protect us and we also would like some type of shelter, whether it is a shed, stable, valley, a copse of trees. Also the amount of, and type of rugging can be quite individual, depending on the age and health of the horse. If the horse is clipped, then his natural fur needs to be replaced with something to keep him warm. This usually involves 3 rugs -a cotton under sheet, a woollen rug and an outer rainproof rug. Or you may need to only use two. Whichever way you choose to use, make sure that as each rug is secured, that it is only secured to itself and not to any of the other rugs (and with the clips facing to the inside!) In the hotter months, some horses do wear a light summer sheet, but ultimately it is preferable to provide shade and shelter for your horse than putting a rug on him. On a severe or catastrophic day it would definitely be preferable to go without. Now I am a big one for comfort! I do like to have somewhere where I can lie down and feel both safe and comfortable (eg. A sand pit) Not all of us have that luxury, but even somewhere soft and grassy will do! And if I have some companions to share that pleasure with, so much the better!

Let's hope this summer will pass without any traumas to property, humans and animals. Keep safe everyone, don't forget to give your equines a special treat for Christmas!



HISTORY CORNER

History of Roadside Mailboxes in Cherry Gardens

Cherry Gardens was first settled in 1838 and in the next 20 years the settlement grew with the church being built in 1849 and the first school in 1860. There is a record of a Post Office being opened in Cherry Gardens as early as 1850 although the first local records of a Postal Service to Cherry Gardens was in 1866 when Robert Broadbent would use a push bike to collect the mail. There were several unofficial Post Offices in private residences. Arthur Broadbent held the Post Office in the house then known as Fairview on Church Hill (now Hicks Hill Road) and it was later re-opened in Joe Lewis's house.

The Post Office was later moved to Cherry Gardens Road on the corner of what is now Jacobs Road and operated by Nelly Breily. The Post Office changed hands a number of times after this including Alice Ricks, Joey Pappin and finally Lester Jones.

Lester Jones operated the Post Office from the property where the Cherry Gardens Hedge is now located. This Post Office was officially closed in 1976 and a new method for getting the mail was required. Australia Post contracted delivery of the mail and residents had to provide a mailbox out the front of their property.

The contractor was only allowed to deliver mail along the main road so all residents that lived off the main road (such as Dorsett Vale Road, Star and Arrow Road, Jacobs Road, Hicks Hill Road, Brumby Road, Marshall Road) had to place their Roadside Mailbox along the main road (Cherry Gardens Road).

This resulted in groups of mailboxes appearing along Cherry Gardens Road wherever a side road intersected the main road.

The numbers on the mailboxes were chosen by the residents however the numbering followed the normal odd and even numbers on each side of the road. Those people living on the side roads still used a similar numbering system and used the name of the side road however their mailbox was placed on Cherry Gardens Road.

Residents added the letters RMB in front of the number to signify Roadside Mailbox. This system operated successfully until around 10 years ago when residents were advised that a new system of rural numbering would be implemented using the distance each house was from the start of the road. The number 620 would indicate the house was 6.2km's from the start of the road.

Under this system again residents on side roads still had to erect their letter box on the main road as the Post Office contractor was only allowed to deliver along the main road.

This system has worked well for 40 plus years in Cherry Gardens and many other districts throughout the Adelaide Hills.

NEW ERA FOR COUNCIL **MEETINGS**

Onkaparinga Council meetings are now being recorded and made available online.

SANTOS FESTIVAL OF CYCLING ANNOUNCED **FOR 2021**

The Santos Tour Down Under has announced a new and reimagined event for 2021, with the Santos Festival of Cycling descending on the City of Onkaparinga on Saturday 23 January.

A six-day domestic Santos Festival of Cycling (19-24 January) will be held in lieu of the Santos Tour Down Under (cancelled due to COVID-19). The event will include a variety of cycling disciplines such as road, track, paracycling, BMX, mountain biking and cyclo-cross.

The program will kick off with the Adelaide Track Event at the Gepps Cross Superdrome, followed by a four-stage National Road Series (NRS) race. Men's and Women's

race stages will be held on the same day, showcasing the Onkaparinga, Barossa and Adelaide Hills regions.

The City of Onkaparinga will host the Be Safe Be Seen Stage 3 (men: 88.2km / women: 48.8km) on Saturday 23 January, which will travel through McLaren Vale, Aldinga Beach and Willunga, with the road races starting at McLaren Vale's iconic d'Arenberg Cube.

Selected events will be ticketed due to COVID-19 restrictions, including limitedcapacity entry for the road race start and finishes. Free tickets are available at tourdownunder.com.au

If tickets become exhausted, cycling fans will be encouraged to find alternative vantage points along the routes to enjoy the race in a COVID-safe and socially distanced way.


